## Judges Critique

I believe that this was a numerically good entry, there being two CCs available over the week-end. Having judged this breed now three times in the UK in recent years and quite frequently in Scandinavia, it is evident to me that we keep drifting apart when it comes to breed type. I do not think this is healthy for the future of the breed. I am quite proud of the, in my view, very positive influence that several great breeders in my own country have had on the development of this breed worldwide and sadly find a very significant number of UK Dalmatians to be lacking both in substance and balance between fronts and rears. Few dogs on this day excelled in a proper forechest and lay-back of upper arms, and this was not in harmony with their well angulated rears, not infrequently resulting in a sloping topline, especially on the move. The top winners, however, were lovely representatives of the breed.

PD (4,1) 1 Lornlee Time To Shine. A well made dog, not big, but masculine enough at this age, especially in his head which is of pleasing proportions, width and length of skull and muzzle. Excellent ears. Strong neck. Moderate, balanced angulation both ends. Deep chest and well developed body for his age, eleven months. Very good legs and feet. A sound and positive mover, he truly stood out in the class. Well spotted, excellent coat. Best puppy. 2 Dalmaigheo Neon Tiger. At seven months old, this dog is very leggy and gangly. He needs to widen and strengthen a lot in skull and muzzle. Long ears. Very good rise of neck. He needs much more layback of upper arm. Very good topline standing. Very youthful and immature in his movement. Well spotted with liver. 3 Dalmaigheo Mr Brightside.

JD (3) 1 Lornlee Bite The Bullet. Well balanced dog with normal construction. Pleasing head, well proportioned. Excellent ears. Good rise of neck. He has enough forechest for his age and a normal return of upper arm. Deep chest. Not fully mature in his body. Matching moderate angulation behind. Nice and easy and well balanced on the move, but he needs to straighten out a little in his topline. Very well spotted. 2 Millbelle Kicking Horses at Cubalibre. A very masculine dog, a great character. Strong and masculine head, I would not want any more of it. Excellent nape of neck. Needs to develop in his forechest and there is an imbalance between the less than angulated front and the well angulated rear. Strong topline, sloping on the move. Too proud of his tail. He moved with plenty of energy and verve, also quite parallel coming and going, he looks much better on the move than standing even with his proud tail. 3 Dalfin Actual Fact.

PGD (2,1)1 Rapanooey Red Rose JW. A very pleasing dog, masculine, combining substance

with quality. Quality head, lovely expression. Ears rather houndy. Strong neck, well set. Moderately angulated in the front, Deep and capacious body, excellent topline, balanced angulation behind. He has excellent coat and spotting. Moved soundly coming and going, balanced from the side, but with just enough extension both ends.

LD (3,1) 1 Dalmaigheo Love Is The Drug. Overly elegant dog, I would prefer much more substance and bone. Head just masculine enough, lovely character. Good neck. I would like more forechest and layback of upper arm. Pleasing topline, falling off too much over the croup. Balanced angulation behind. Pleasing spots. Would like to see more extension and power on the move.

OD (6,1) 1 Tamilanda Midnight Lilly JW. This dog stood out for substance, the type I prefer. He has a well shaped and well proportioned masculine head with excellent expression. Strong neck, well set. He has a good forechest and enough return of upper arm. Deep and capacious body, very pleasing topline and underline. Moderate, balanced angulation behind. He moves well in front, sometimes tending to sidetrack, but at all times keeping his balance on the move. Well spotted, in excellent coat. Excellent legs, bone and feet. For me a very easy standout in the male entry today. CC. 2 Alioth Moonlight Surprise. Another dog with a pleasing balance, and with enough substance. A little round in skull. Very good neck. He also has enough forechest and return of upper arm. Excellent topline, well angulated behind. Well spotted, liver. He moved very well front the side with power and excellent co-ordination, but narrow behind. resCC. 3 Kalokairie's Bullet Proof.

JB (4) 1 Millbelle Fernie JW. Very elegant, feminine bitch, she scored in quality over substance, but has an attractive outline. Feminine head, well proportioned, good ears. Beautiful crested neck, well set into shoulders. Moderate angulation in front. Shapely in body, even if on the short-coupled side, well angulated behind. Well spotted, liver. She moved soundly and efficiently from all angles. 2 Tamilanda Continental Song. Standing still this bitch very much caught my eyes, as I particularly like her proportions, somewhat longer than square. Feminine head, pleasing expression, a little longer in muzzle than I prefer. Good neck into shoulder, excellent topline and tailset. Well spotted. Not as impressive in movement as she tended to lose a little of her balance, still used her legs well enough. 3 Rapanooy Rascallion.

PGB (5,3) 1 Jemblewood Jelly Bean. Very well balanced bitch with pleasing proportions. Classical, feminine head, excellent expression. Long neck, well set. Enough forechest and return of upper arm. Deep chest, I would not want any more tuck-up than this. Well angulated behind. Well spotted. She moved very parallel coming and going and quite pleasing from the side, retaining her balance and topline. A good bitch this! ResCC. 2 Chizzmic Carry On with Cubalibre. Feminine bitch, a great character. Pleasing head. Crested neck. Straight upper arms, not balanced by her angulation behind. Deep chest, firm topline. Moved with energy, but not the silhouette I am looking for on the move, sloping from front to rear. I found more than a few with her challenges today. Well spotted.

LB (6,2) 1 Ellemstra Little Mix with Kalsidoni. A bitch who is very nicely balanced on the stack. She is feminine and has substance to match. Attractive head and expression. Strong neck. Just enough forechest and return of upper arm. Deep and capacious chest, strong topline while standing, well angulated behind. Well spotted. Not as impressive on the move as she is rather unconcentrated, but at times moved well enough to win the class. 2 Dvojica Chilly Chutney for Wrendragge JW. A liver spotted bitch who scored in ease and balance of movement. She has a feminine head, clean neck. Not quite enough angulation either ends, but it matches well as evidenced by her nice and easy movement, parallel coming and going. Just enough body and substance. Very well spotted. 3 Dalpetro Diamond JW.

OB (10,2) 1 Int.Ch. Jezebel The Astonishing Sophtspot JW. This bitch just wowed me today. She is strong, still feminine enough, but what a side mover she is. Head to match her substance. Strong and crested neck. Deep and capacious body, she covers ground both standing and moving. Well angulated both ends, very good forechest. She is close to what I am

looking for in the breed, but only found in a minority in the UK today. Great side movement with plenty of energy, drive and extension both ends, but not quite as great going away. Well spotted and very well handled. Now in her prime, I was impressed and very happy to have her in my ring. CC and BOB. 2 Ch. Dvojica Black Swan At Dalfin SHCM. A classical bitch with excellent proportions and balance. She scores in substance with elegance. Well shaped, feminine head and very pleasing expression. Beautiful neck into shoulder. Enough forechest and return of upper arm. At times her topline could be a little stronger. She moved soundly, but not with anywhere near the enthusiasm or energy of the winner, and in the challenge for the resCC she simply gave in. Beautiful coat and colour. Sympathetically handled. 3 Kiki Dee The Astonishing
